## Weatherall Institute of Molecular Medicine, Oxford

A grant of **£1 million** supported the establishment of the **Weatherall Institute of Molecular Medicine** at the **University of Oxford** to foster research in the field of molecular and cell biology with direct application to the study of human disease.

Since the 1980s the Foundation has awarded annual scholarships for students at junior conservatoires and instrument funds for gifted undergraduates. A large number of grants have also been made for the building and renovation of concert venues, such as **The Royal Welsh College of Music and Drama's** new concert hall, which received **£50,000** in 2009.
